Born in Moncton, Lee Thompson's fiction has been published in five anthologies and more than a dozen literary journals. His first book, *S. a novel in [xxx] dreams*, was published in 2008 by Broken Jaw Press. He was awarded creation grants from the NB Arts Board (2002, 2005) and the Canada Council for the Arts (2006, 2016) and a Banff Writing Studio residency in 2014. He has been active in the New Brunswick literary scene for over fifteen years, working as an editor, publisher, book designer and organizer of the long-running Attic Owl Reading Series.

Lee was executive director of the Writers' Federation of NB from 2009-2014.

A member of the Association of Acadian Artists of NB and the Writers' Federation of NB, he has published three books of poetry. He lives and works in Grand Barachois.
